The county may ask you to provide proof of residency. This request may include such documentation as a valid Utah Driver License, a Utah Voter Registration Card, a Social Security Card, or other similar documents.

Applicant is a: **Blind Person.** *First year applicant must submit a statement by an ophthalmologist verifying that there is no more than 20/200 visual acuity in the better eye when corrected or have a restriction in the field of vision of the better eye which subtends an angle of vision no greater than 20 degrees.*

Unremarried surviving spouse or minor orphan. *First year applicant must submit a copy of the blind person's death certificate.*

The first \$11,500 of taxable value of real and tangible personal property in this state owned by blind persons, their unremarried surviving spouses, or their minor orphans is exempt from taxation.
