

## REQUIREMENTS FOR RELOCATING EXISTING STRUCTURES March 1st 2013

No relocating of structures on county property prior to verifying property zoning and obtaining a building permit with structure meeting the following:

| 5. Smoke/Co detectors must meet current Building Code   |   |
| 6. All sleeping areas must have minimum of one means of egress (door or window) meeting current Building Code, minimum 5.7 sq. ft. openable area.   |   |
| 7. Submit complete footing and foundation plan including reinforcement and size showing 30" below grade for frost (provide engineering)   |   |
| 8. Submit details for anchoring and tie down to foundation (must be stamped by Engineer)  |   |
| 9. When property is located within Utah Wildlands Urban Interface Zone the structure must meet all ignition resistant construction as required by the 2006 Wildland Urban Interface 1 hr exterior requirements. |   |
| Note: #'s 4, 5 & 6 Do not apply to unaltered Manufactured Homes meeting HUD   |   |
